

1. Fill in your user name and password in the left corner of the main page of the site. From the menu choose the link which lead you to the page where all the tests are listed.
2. Choose the test that you want to solve by clicking it's name.
3. All the questions that have a square box have 2 correct answers and those marked with circle have 1 correct answer.
4. Attention: Some tests may have limited times for sloving. See the text in red.
5. Attention: You can't go back and change your answers after using the button "Submit"
6. "Evaluation criteria" - The teacher has chose the value scale.
 - 6.1. If a question with one correct answer is correctly answered it brings 1 point.
 - 6.2. Question with more than one correct answer can't have more than 2 correct answers.
 - 6.2.1. If you answer correct to 2 of the right subsections you will get 1 point.
 - 6.2.2. If you choose one correct and one incorrect answer you will get 0,25 point.
 - 6.2.3. If you choose 1 correct answer and do not mark wrong the other answer you will get 0,5 point.
 - 6.2.4. If you choose more than 2 answers you will not get any points because this will be taken as guessing.
7. The total number of the questions will define the total points which can be received. According to this total number of the questions you can calculate the per cent of the correct answers.
8. The teacher has pointed the per cent's scale which will create your mark. For example:

Excellent	5,5-6,00=A	from 100% to 85%
Very Good	4,5-5,49=B	from 84% to 70%
Good	4,0-4,49=C	from 69% to 60%
Good	3,5-3,99=D	from 59% to 50%
Fair	3,0-3,49=E	from 49% to 40%
Poor	2,5-2,99=FX	from 39% to 35%
Poor	2,0-2,49=F	under 35%
9. After finishing the test click on the button "Submit" at the end of the page. Your answers will be checked by the system and you will see a page which contain information about your result.
10. You see a table which contain the questions from the test.
 - 10.1. If the teacher has set such properties you will see the correct answers and their explanations.
 - 10.2. If the aim of this test is to check your knowledge it's possible to see only your results. This depend on how the teacher has configured the test.
11. Under this table you can see the summary of your results and the value scale.
12. From the page with the list of the tests you can see a statistic for every test you have solved. There you will see a bar diagram showing the results of every student who has solved this test. In the table under the diagram you can only see your own test results.
13. You can sort your results in different criterias from the drop-down menu.
